DAY 2: MONTE CARLO, MONACO

With an area of less than one square mile, this city-state packs excitement and attractions into its small space, including the glamorous Monte Carlo Casino and the Circuit de Monaco, the site of the famed Grand Prix.

DAY 3: FLORENCE/PISA/TUSCANY (LIVORNO), ITALY

The architectural and artistic masterpieces of the Renaissance— Brunelleschi's Duomo, the Baptistery, Michelangelo's *David*, the Ponte Vecchio, and the Uffizi Gallery—await you in Florence, the capital of Tuscany. Pisa's Field of Miracles and iconic Leaning Tower also beckon, as does the rural Tuscan countryside, renowned for its gently rolling hills, medieval hilltop villages, and world-class wines.

DAY 4: ROME (CIVITAVECCHIA), ITALY

Once the center of the world's greatest empire and now the capital of modern Italy, Rome displays relics of its past wherever you look. With legendary sites including the ancient Roman Forum, the Colosseum, St. Peter's Basilica, and Michelangelo's breathtaking frescoes in the Sistine Chapel, Rome is a monumental city rich in antiquity and culture.

DAY 5: SORRENTO/CAPRI, ITALY

Delight in the cobblestone streets, seaside promenades, and vibrant southern Italian culture of Sorrento. Explore the historic palace then check out Split's Archaeological Museum, peruse the many restaurants and shops in town, or climb up to the bell tower of St. Dominus Cathedral, the oldest Catholic cathedral in the world.
