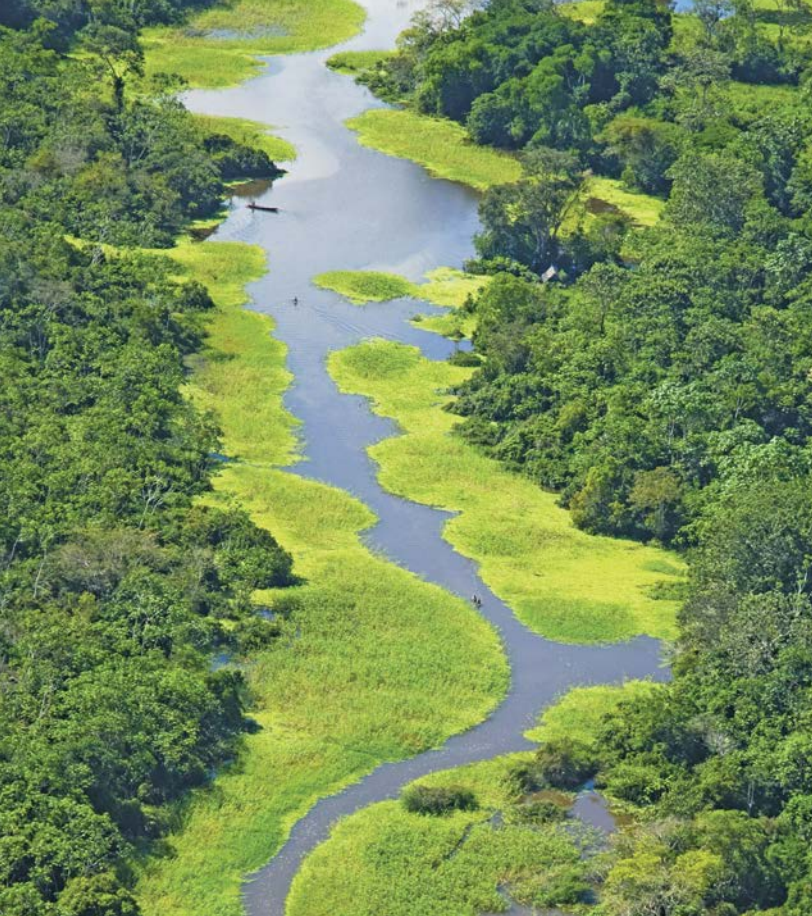

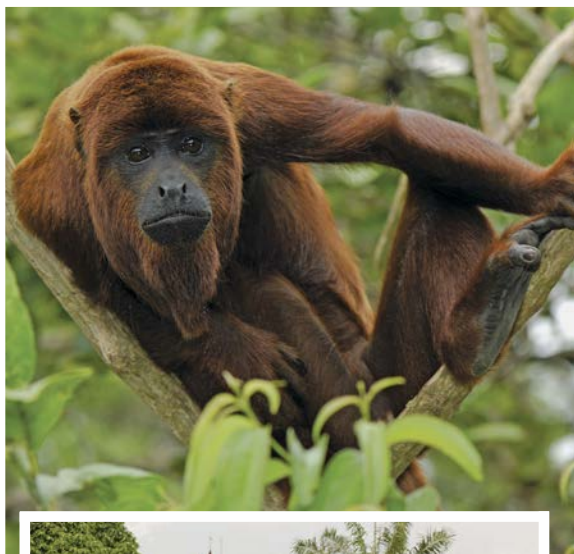

Day One

In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Lima, Peru.✈
Upon arrival, transfer✈ and check in to the Casa Andina Private Collection Miraflores.

Day Two

B | D

Lima, Peru

Discovery: Highlights of Lima. Visit the Larco Museum, covering more than 5,000 years of pre-Columbian Peruvian history. Lima was the heart of Spain's South American empire for 300 years. In the city's historic centre, a UNESCO World Heritage site, explore Plaza Mayor and the buildings encircling it: President's Palace, City Hall and the Cathedral of Lima with its stunning interior. Step inside the Monastery of San Francisco, containing a beautifully decorated church, a library with 25,000 antique volumes and bone-filled catacombs beneath the chapels.

Enrichment: Meet the People. This evening, gather at Casa Garcia Alvarado, a family home and a National Historical Building. Take a tour of the elegant house and then delight in a typical Peruvian home-cooked meal in the company of one of the owners.

Day Three

Lima | Iquitos | Embark | Marayali

Transfer to Lima's airport for your flight to Iquitos, the gateway to the Amazon, accessible only by plane or boat.



Discovery: Iquitos. Journey through the bustling streets where the city's historical flavour can be seen in rickshaws, colourful tuk-tuks and 19th-century mansions.

Afterward, travel to Nauta, a small riverside town on the Marañon River. Along the way, see the vibrant "terra firma" (non-flooded forest) and other aspects of daily jungle life. Upon arrival in Nauta, embark the Delfin III at a private port.

Discovery: Marayali. Travel by skiff boats to a spot favoured by iguanas, sloths and anteaters.

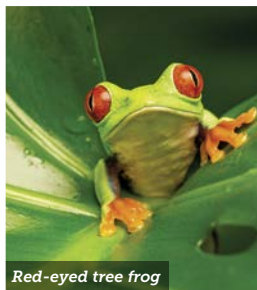
Later, delight in the fantastic panoramic views from the observation deck as your naturalist guide discusses your upcoming activities and the wildlife and vegetation that you are likely to see.

Discovery: Amazonas Nighttime Jungle Walk.

Before dinner, head out on a thrilling walk through the jungle at night. Stop at a small village, then sit around a crackling campfire and listen as your guides share Amazonian legends.

Day Four

Cruising: Yarapa River | Yucuruchi | Fundo Casual

Discovery: Yarapa River. Glide along this tributary and discover the giant Amazonian water lily, Victoria regia, a lovely aquatic plant that grows in small lagoons known as cochas. Hike a trail that offers excellent bird watching, and learn about caciques and oropendolas.

Discovery: Fundo Casual. With an expert guide, hike into the rain forest, where canopy trees, like the Kapok, grow 55 metres high.

Enrichment: Contemporary Peru. Learn how modern Peru has been shaped by its past.

Day Five

Cruising: Yanayacu | Nauta Cano

Discovery: Yanayacu. Skim along this river and see brilliant parrots, hummingbirds and hawks. Spot pink and grey dolphins swimming below and red howler monkeys in the canopy above. You will even have the opportunity to swim in the river along with the famous pink dolphins!

Discovery: Nauta Caño Creek. Set off on an exhilarating piranha fishing adventure. Over 25 different species of piranhas live in the Amazon River Basin. Later, embark on a guided night safari in search of caiman alligators and night birds.

Day Six

Disembark | Iquitos | Cusco

After breakfast, disembark the Delfin III in Nauta and transfer via coach to the Iquitos airport.

En route, visit the Manatee Rescue Centre, where you can learn about conservation efforts, see these gentle creatures up close and even feed them with a bottle of milk.

Board your flight for Cusco via Lima. Upon arrival in Cusco, enjoy lunch, then take a scenic drive to Urubamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas.

Check in to the Casa Andina Private Collection Valle Sagrado, and dine there tonight.

Day Seven

Sacred Valley

Discovery: Sacred Valley. Explore the ruins of the massive Incan fortress, Ollantaytambo. Then visit a remote village seemingly frozen in time. Meet with local citizens to learn about their daily life, as well as the centuries-old agricultural

methods they have used in this challenging Andean mountain environment. Later, visit a ranch for lunch and an equestrian demonstration.

Day Eight

Sacred Valley | Machu Picchu

Take a scenic train ride through the Sacred Valley to Aguas Calientes and the Inkaterra Machu Picchu Pueblo hotel, which sit at the foot of Machu Picchu.

Discovery: Machu Picchu. Nestled in a cloud forest, the Lost City of the Inca is arguably the most important archaeological site in the Americas. Wander through grassy plazas, stone temples and palaces with an expert guide.

Free Time: The afternoon is at leisure.

Day Nine

Free Time: The morning is at leisure.

This afternoon, travel to Cusco and check in to the Casa Andina Private Collection Cusco.

Cusco

Discovery: Cusco, Ancient Incan Capital.

This sacred city is perched 3,399 metres above sea level. Enjoy a city tour which includes the Cathedral on the Plaza de Armas, noted for its colonial art; and the Santo Domingo Temple.

Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant.

Discovery: Sacsayhuaman. Marvel at these impressive Incan ruins, built with massive stones (one weighs 125 tons!) without any mortar.

After breakfast, depart for Cusco's airport and fly to Lima.

In Lima, conclude your Peruvian adventures with a Farewell Reception at the Casa Andina Private Collection Miraflores hotel. Transfer✈ to the Lima airport for your international flight home.

Arrive in your gateway city.

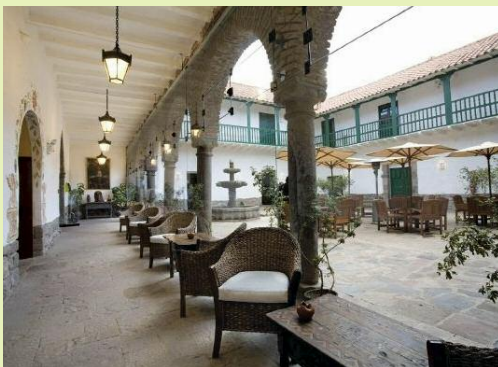
