DISCOVERY

San Sebastián. This seaside town, called Donostia in Basque, is the 2016 European Capital of Culture. See its Old Town, including Buen Pastor Cathedral. Walk on La Concha Promenade along the beautiful bay.

Bayonne. Bayonne sits in the heart of France's Basque Country. See Sainte-Marie Cathedral, a stop on The Way of St. James. Bayonne also has a sweet and salty reputation as the first place in France where luscious chocolate was produced, as well as the center of production for Bayonne ham, a cousin of serrano ham produced south of the border. Enjoy a tasting of both plus wine.

Biarritz. Formerly a whaling town on the Bay of Biscay, Biarritz today is a chic seaside resort. Visit the old fishing port and the medieval Atalaye watch tower, where careful eyes looked for whales.

La Rioja Wine. Explore the medieval town of Laguardia, center of La Rioja wine country. Visit a family-owned winery for a tour and wine tasting.

Espelette. Explore this pretty town, where strands of the eponymous red peppers adorn whitewashed homes, the traditional method of drying the peppers.

St-Jean-de-Luz. This pretty town has a swashbuckling past! In the 17th and 18th centuries, fishermen traded their nets for swords and cannons to become feared corsairs. Learn about its exciting history during a walking tour and enjoy a cruise on the Bay of Biscay.

Bilbao. Explore the Guggenheim Museum Bilbao, designed by Frank Gehry. Visit a sidrería, a cider maker, for lunch and a cider tasting. The Basque are known for their hard cider, known as sidra, a traditional drink.
